

Ramaker Stables - Winter Weather and Blanketing Form

(for stalled horses only):

Ramaker Stables will blanket your horse when the weather is below 40 degrees if you provide the blanket and you have filled out this form. Please put the blanket that you want on your horse in front of your stall on a bar or chain only. If you need a chain in front of your stall, inform Tami Ramaker.

The horses stay in their stalls if it is going to be below 40 degrees. Blankets will be taken off the horses before they are turned out unless you specify otherwise on this form.

Please put your horse's name on his/her blanket. We are not responsible for loss or damage to your horse's blanket or if your horse gets injured while blanketed.

We monitor the weather the best we can, but weather can be unpredictable. We do our very best to only put horses out according to the weather, but there is no guarantee that the weather will not change. We will put on blankets around 7:00 p.m. at night (or after feeding) for the night and will take them off in the morning unless the temperature is not going to be above 40 degrees for the day.

This is included in your board:

- Please blanket my horse (in his/her stall) if it is 40 degrees or below.
- My horse can be turned out with his/her sheet and/or blanket on.
- Special Instructions: _____

For an additional charge of \$12 per month, you can add the following service:

- Put a sheet on my horse between 45 degrees and 60 degrees and a blanket over the sheet if it is going to be below 45 degrees.
